**RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING
ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Cary has received an annexation petition of

**P&P Balaji Enterprise, LLC
2.388 acres plus 0 acres of adjacent right-of-way;**

requesting the annexation of the area described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has certified to the Town Council the sufficiency of said Petition as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Cary, North Carolina that:

Section 1. A public hearing on the question of annexation of the area described herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the Town of Cary, 316 N. Academy Street, Cary, N.C. at 6:30 p.m. on **7/26/2018**.

Section 2. The area proposed for annexation is described as follows:


LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

Beginning at an existing iron pipe having N.C. Grid Coordinates (NAD 83/2011) of N=732,494.73, E= 2,036,654.48, thence from said beginning point South 81°23'14" East 240.34 feet to a rebar set on the western Right of Way of North Carolina Highway 55 (Variable width R/W), thence along said Right of Way South 08°35'44" West 466.93 feet to a rebar set at the intersection of said Right of Way and the northern Right of Way of Jenks Road (Variable width R/W), thence leaving said Right of Way and along the northern Right of Way of Jenks Road (Variable width R/W) South 55°55'27" West 49.75 feet to a rebar set on said Right of Way, thence continuing along said Right of Way South 84°34'33" West 132.03 feet to a rebar set on said Right of Way, thence leaving said Right of Way North 00°30'42" East 538.05 feet to the point and place of Beginning containing 2.388 Acres more or less.

If this is a contiguous annexation, the annexation area also includes all intervening streets, street rights-of-way, creeks, rivers, rights-of-way of any railroad or other public service corporation, or lands owned by the State of North Carolina or any of its political subdivisions.

Section 3. Notice of public hearing shall be duly published on the Town of Cary website at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the public hearing.
